SUBJECT: 30th Space Wing (30 SW) Environmental Commitment Statement (ECS)

1. Vandenberg's critical national defense mission provides combat capabilities through launch, range, and expeditionary operations. The 30 SW recognizes its responsibilities to conduct its mission sustainably, reduce pollution, maintain regulatory compliance, and try to avoid adverse environmental impacts through its Environmental Management System (EMS) Program.
2. The 30 SW Environmental, Safety, and Occupational Health Council will review the 30 SW EMS Program and ECS at least annually, and consider the EMS Cross Functional Team (CFT) inputs and recommendations to set and review environmental objectives and targets.
3. All Team Vandenberg Members will commit to:
  - a. Comply with Federal, state, and local laws, and Federal policy requirements, and assiduously correct non-compliance.
  - b. Using environmentally friendly and recycled materials, diverting solid waste, minimizing hazardous waste, and reducing air pollution.
  - c. Maintain an effective EMS and participate organizationally on the 30 SW EMS CFT.
  - d. Promote energy conservation and sustainable resource use.
  - e. Build environmental concerns into all guidance, programs, and missions and encourage mission partners, suppliers, contractors, and other stakeholders to do the same.
  - f. Foster awareness through training and community involvement.
  - g. Continually improve the 30 SW EMS Program and EMS.
4. Commanders will appoint CFT members and Unit Environmental Coordinators in writing and ensure organizational personnel know the environmental requirements that apply to their daily duties and receive environmental education and training commensurate with those duties.
