Escort and Sponsor Privileges

1. <u>Active Duty/Retired Mil ID card holders</u>	Yes	Yes	
2. <u>Dependent ID card holders</u>	Yes	Yes	Must be 18 years of age or older
3. <u>Contractor CAC card holders</u>	No	Yes	
4. <u>DoD Civilian ID card holders</u>	Yes	Yes	
5. <u>Retired DoD Civilian ID card holders</u>	No	Yes	
6. <u>DBIDS Card/Pass & AF FM 75</u>	No	No	**Unless authorized through VCC. Must be annotated on DBIDS card**
7. <u>Federal Bureau of Prison employees</u>	Yes	No	Immediate family members only
8. <u>Federal PIV credentials</u>	No	No	DoE, DoJ, EPA, DoS, DHS, NASA, USPS
9. <u>Non-DoD Fed PIV-I</u>	No	No	Raytheon, Booz Allen Hamilton, Northrop Grumman, Lockheed Martin, and NASA.
10. <u>OSI, FBI, USSS Credentials</u>	Yes	Yes	On official business w/ presentation of their credentials
11. <u>Dept of Veterans Affairs</u>	No	No	
12. <u>Foreign Nationals</u>	No	No	Foreign Visitors must be sponsors at the VCC. **Permanent Party Foreign Liaison Officers limited escort authority**
13. <u>Access Credential (DL/Passport)</u>	No	No	May only be utilized in conjunction with current EAL. ALL EAL's must be processed through VCC.

* Sponsorship by an individual is only valid for up to 30 days when pass is issued by VCC

* Sponsorship by an organization is valid for up to 12 months when pass is issued by VCC

* IECs may only issue passes valid for 24 hrs

Note: Red lines on paper passes indicates individual is unauthorized to drive

Sponsor: Request for a visitor to be allowed unescorted access for the times/days/locations specified by the sponsor.

Escort: Visitor must be accompanied by sponsor AT ALL times. Visitor must be in the same vehicle as the sponsor.
